Welcome to Granada

WALK FROM THE HOTEL DEPARTURE: 20:00

Starting in Plaza Nueva, we walk along the banks of the river Darro and Paseo de los Tristes. This area is occupied in part by the old Spanish and Arab quarter and full of impressive 16th century palaces that are important testimonies of the city's historic past. Visitors will discover the scenic and cultural wealth of one of the most unique World Heritage landmarks in Granada.

A tour of this Arab style urban labyrinth will lead us through cobblestone streets, blind alleys, and villas with gardens, courtyards and fountains steeped in Arab tradition. The walk ends at the viewpoint known as el Mirador de San Nicolás, where you can contemplate an unparalleled view of the Alhambra and Sierra Nevada mountains, as well as a panoramic view of the city.

FLAMENCO

Our walk ends with a good flamenco show and typical Granada tapas in the oldest flamenco enthusiasts' club in Spain, known as La Peña de la Platería.
