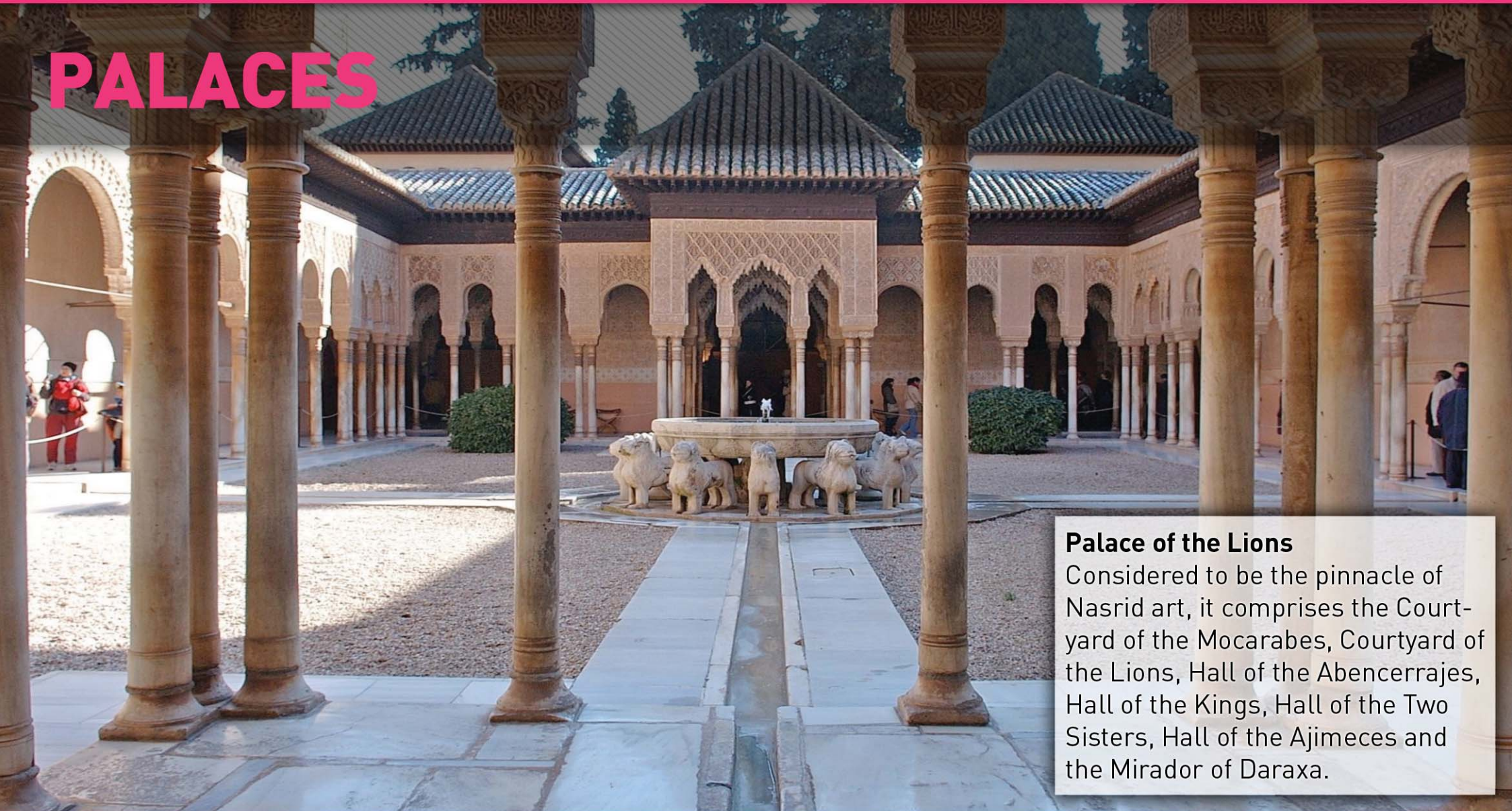
The Mexuar Palace

This was the Sultan's official residence and throne room. It includes the Courtyard of the Myrtles, Hall of the Boat and Hall of Ambassadors

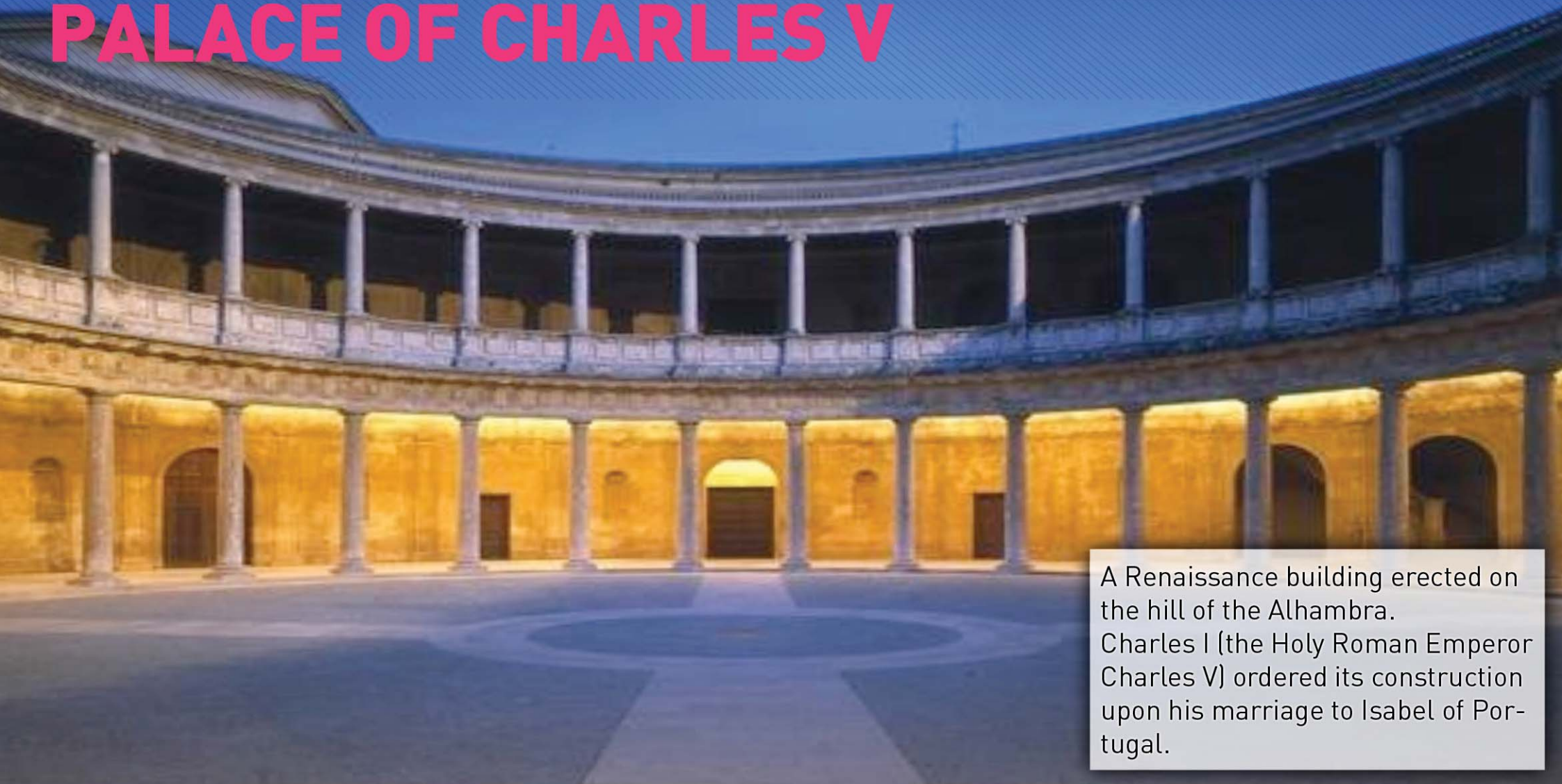

Palace of the Lions

Considered to be the pinnacle of Nasrid art, it comprises the Courtyard of the Mocarabes, Courtyard of the Lions, Hall of the Abencerrajes, Hall of the Kings, Hall of the Two Sisters, Hall of the Ajimeces and the Mirador of Daraxa.

PALACE OF CHARLES V



A Renaissance building erected on the hill of the Alhambra. Charles I (the Holy Roman Emperor Charles V) ordered its construction upon his marriage to Isabel of Portugal.
