# BARRANCO DEL POQUEIRA VALLEY

The Barranco de Poqueira valley is one of the most renowned areas of the Alpujarras in Granada province. Practically suspended over the valley slopes, in staggered terraces over the ravine lie the three loveliest villages in the Alpujarras: Capileira, Bubi3n and Pampaneira.

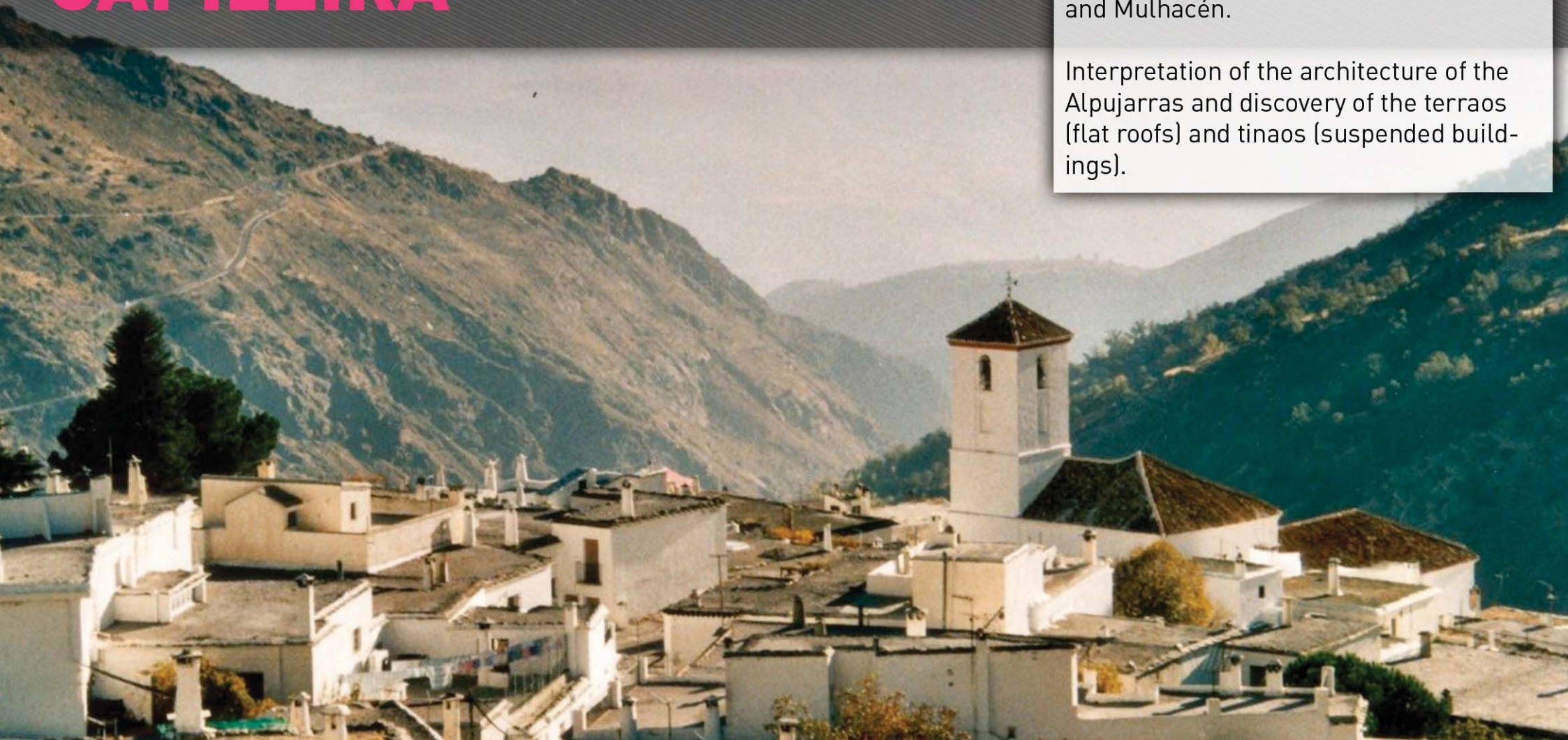
Three picturesque towns that have preserved their original architecture, which can be traced back to the Berber tribes that settled in this area.



# CAPILEIRA

A tour through a town with views of the highest peaks in mainland Spain: Veleta and Mulhacén.

Interpretation of the architecture of the Alpujarras and discovery of the terraos (flat roofs) and tinaos (suspended buildings).





# BUBIÓN

A tour through a labyrinth of narrow streets in this peaceful, unspoiled town





# PAMPANEIRA

A lovely town that has wisely preserved its Moorish heritage. We will take a tour of its narrow streets to visit a loom where the typical Alpujarra rugs (jarapas) are still woven by hand, a public washing place that was used until 1965, and a factory.
