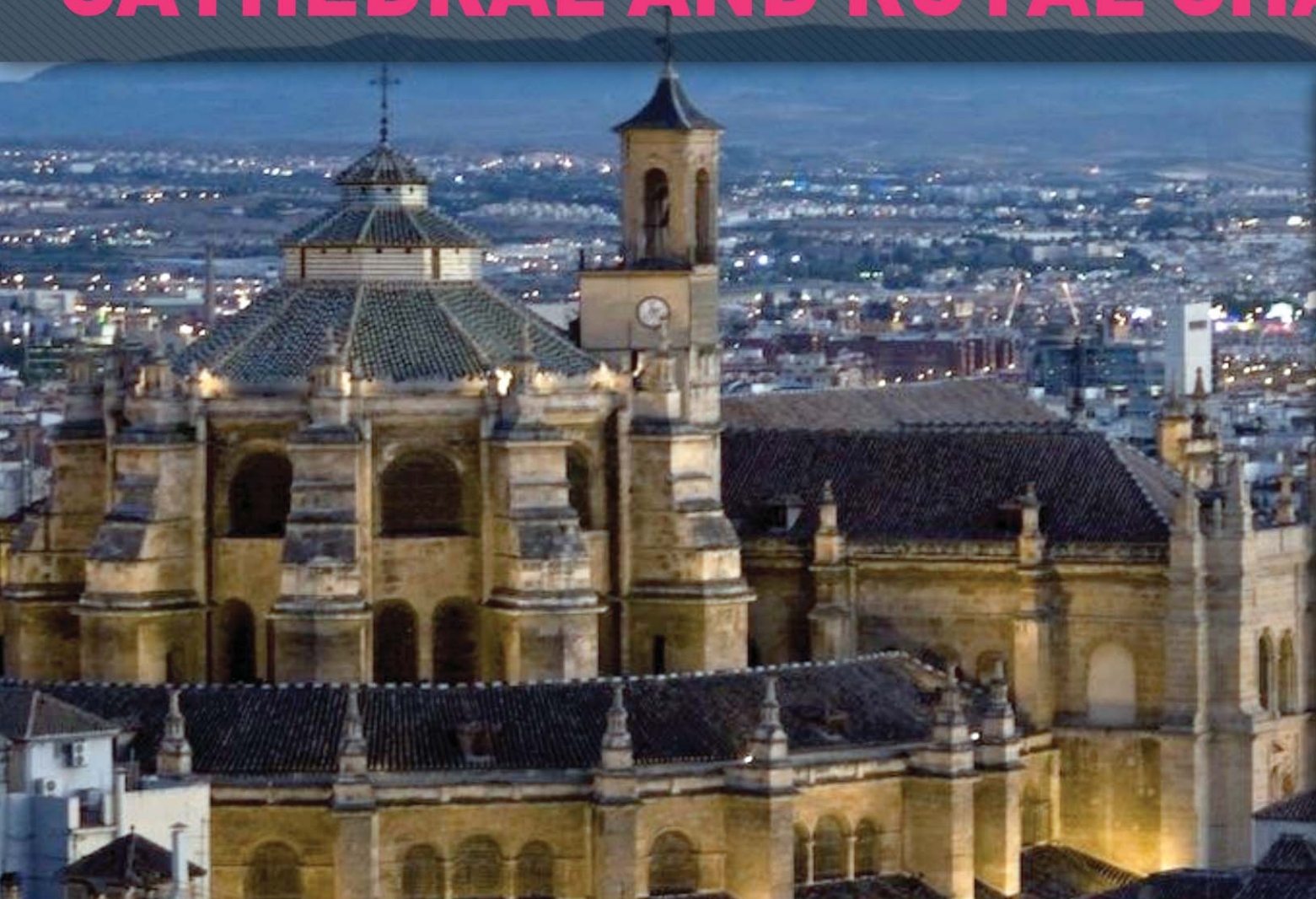
WALK FROM THE HOTEL

We will come across plazas, historical monuments and interesting streets that will take us back to the past

CATHEDRAL AND ROYAL CHAPEL



The Cathedral

An emblem of Spanish architecture, built on top of the great Nazrid Mosque in Granada. It is considered to be the first Renaissance church built in Spain.

The Royal Chapel

The Royal Chapel stands between the Cathedral, a corner of the former Merchant's Exchange known as the Lonja, and the Church of El Sagrario. It was built in 1504 for Ferdinand and Isabella in the Isabelline Gothic style, as a burial place for the monarchs, their daughter Juana and her husband Felipe el Hermoso.

ALCAICERÍA



A stroll through this quarter is always interesting. A former Arab silk market, it was destroyed by fire and rebuilt according to its original layout. We continue our walk along calle Zacatín and cross calle Reyes Católicos to visit the Corral del Carbon.

One of the oldest monuments in Granada, it was an inn for Arab merchants and a storehouse for their merchandise, including the coal from which the building gets its name.

TAPAS TOUR

We will end our visit by taking a tour of the city's most popular bars and restaurants to savour their delicious tapas.
