Museum of the Culture of the Olive Tree

The museum is located at the geographical centre of the province of Jaén, only 8 km from Baeza. It is housed in a 17th century farmhouse known as La Laguna that once belonged to the Jesuits and the Ducal House of Alba.

It is the largest monographic museum in Europe. To tour the museum is to visualise olive growing as a cultural manifestation and discover the technical aspects of olive oil production in the extraction and storage rooms.

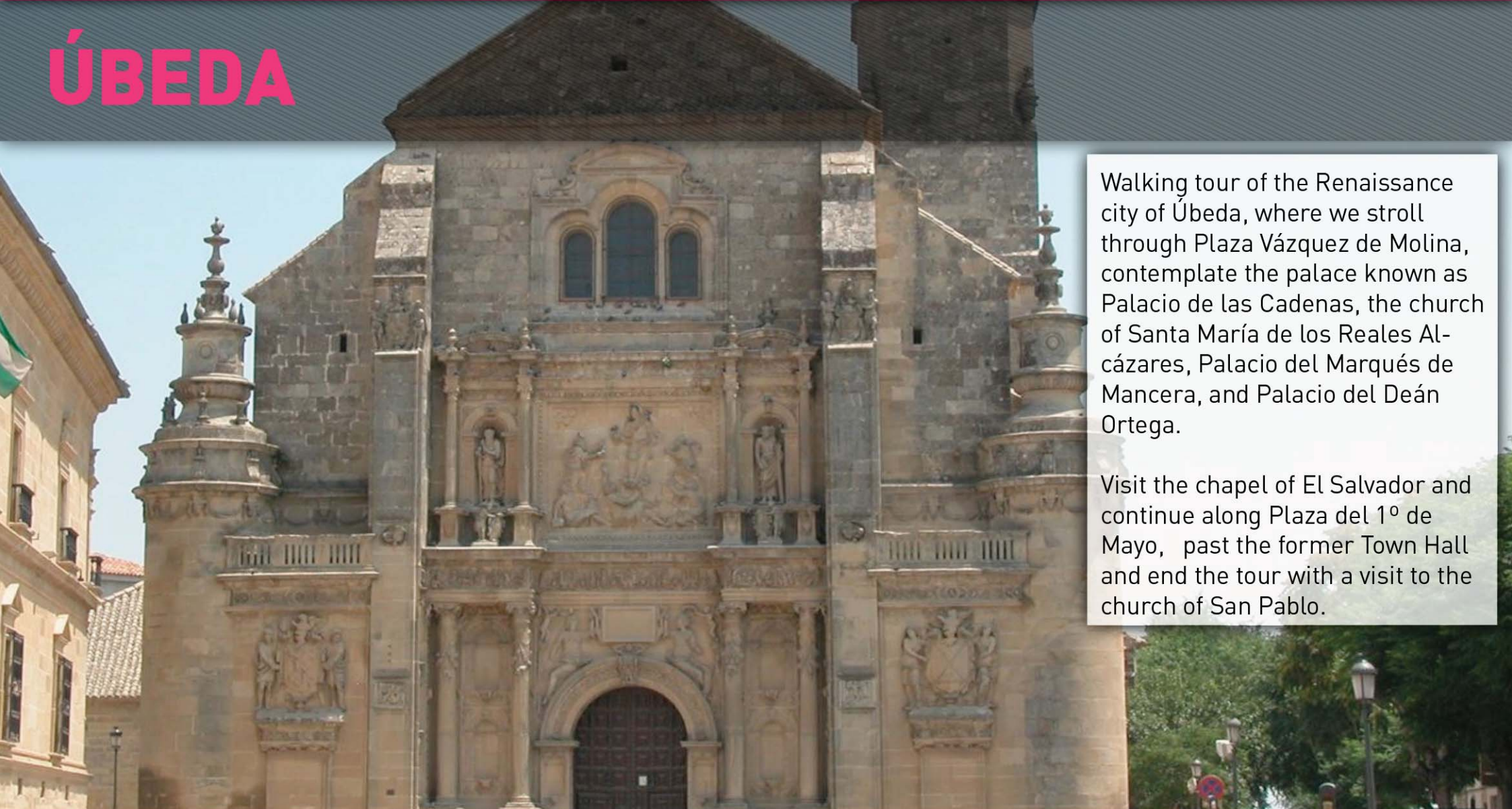
We set out from Plaza del Pópulo, also known as Plaza de los Leones (taking in the old abattoir, the old Civil Court, the old gateway known as the Puerta de Jaén and Arco de Villalar, and the fountain known as the Fuente de los Leones); the Plaza de Santa María, where we find the old seminary; the Town Hall, the Fuente de Santa María and the Cathedral of Baeza (taking a look inside).

We stroll through the nearby Puerta de la Luna, past Plaza del Arcediano and the viewing point known as the Balcón del Guadalquivir to enter the church of Santa Cruz, built in the Romanic style; then the Palacio de Jabalquinto; the University, inside the Aula de Antonio Machado and the Paraninfo; Plaza de la Constitución and Balcón del Concejo.

Walking tour of the Renaissance city of Úbeda, where we stroll through Plaza Vázquez de Molina, contemplate the palace known as Palacio de las Cadenas, the church of Santa María de los Reales Alcázares, Palacio del Marqués de Mancera, and Palacio del Deán Ortega.

Visit the chapel of El Salvador and continue along Plaza del 1º de Mayo, past the former Town Hall and end the tour with a visit to the church of San Pablo.
